Crushed Gravel Bid Specifications

<u>Item #1</u>	20,000 ton, 23A, Modified	1. Max. 55% passing the #8 sieve 2. Loss by washing target of 10%
<u>Item #2</u>	10,000 ton, 22A, Modified	1. Max. 45% passing the #8 sieve 2. Loss by washing range 6% to 9% 3. Loss by washing target 7%
<u>Item #3</u>	Winter Maintenance Sand	1. Reject sand from gravel production. 2. Shall meet MDOT specification for Ice Control Sand, I.C.S.

Contractor will be required to test and certify that the aggregate meets the current M.D.O.T. modified specification. Recommended test frequency is one test per each 1000 tons produced. The Road Commission will perform random tests on materials produced for acceptance. Contractor will be required to furnish clay or any other materials deemed necessary to accommodate the specification. Cost of furnishing these materials shall be incidental to aggregate production.

General

The RCRC stockpile must be completely separate from all other stockpile and accessible at all times. If stockpile is determined by the RCRC to be segregated, it will be unacceptable for use.

All permits, permit fees, and royalties for the production of material will be procured by the Contractor prior to production.

If test indicate moisture content in excess of 6 percent, the excess over 6 percent will be deducted from the scale weight of aggregate until such time as tests indicate that the moisture content is not more than 6 percent. The determination of moisture content and pay weights will be as specified in section 109 of the MDOT 2003 Standard Specification for Construction

It is the intent of the Road Commission to verify stockpile quantity by cross-section survey and average unit weights. The Road Commission must be notified 5 days prior to production to conduct a base line survey of the stockpile area.

The Contractor shall complete the entire project on or before the completion date specified. If the Contractor fails to complete the entire project on time they will be charged liquidated damages per section 108 of the MDOT 2012 Standard Specification for Construction.

Contractor shall provide a Certificate of Insurance prior to commencing the project. Certificate shall include: **1)** Board of County Road Commissioners and Roscommon County Road Commission named as additional insured to all coverage, **2)** General liability - \$1,000,000 each occurrence, **3)** Automotive liability - \$1,000,000 each occurrence, and **4)** Worker's Compensation statutory limits.
